  - To review periodically the allocation of siting responsibility for hazardous waste management facilities based upon the most current waste generation figures.
  - To promote hazardous waste minimization by encouraging on-site source reduction, recycling and treatment.
  - To promote regulatory compliance, pollution prevention and resource conservation through the Bay Area Green Business Program.
  - To identify and implement other source reduction and pollution prevention strategies.
